SICK POLICY

We will post if the class has been exposed to an infectious disease such as chicken pox, measles, fifth disease, conjunctivitis (pink eye) or lice, to name a few. Those children who are not immunized must remain out of school until the contagion period has been deemed over. This can be as long as two weeks.

However, we will not post each time a child has a cough or runny nose. We will send your child home if they have a fever, uncontrollable cough or excessive green mucous.

If your child requires **any medication**, and this includes cough syrup, cold medicine, Tylenol or ibuprofen, **do not bring your child to school**. Should a child become ill at school, we will call the parent and separate the child from the class until they are picked up. If parents or other Emergency contacts cannot be reached, it is the state of Arizona statute to have Child Protective Services contacted.

Common sense should prevail upon you to keep your child home when they exhibit symptoms such as a **green mucous** in the nose (evidence of an infection), continual weeping eyes or excessive coughing. We trust you, the parent, to be able to make those judgments prior to bringing your child to school. We will assess on a case by case basis as to whether to allow a child to attend school or whether to call a parent to come pick up a child from school.
